Equipment needed:

Playdough or plasticine Mats Trays

Instructions:

This activity encourages pupils to be grateful. It encourages them to think about people, things and places that they like.

If your prayer space is in a carpeted room, use the mats to mark out an area. It is best to keep the playdough on trays if possible.

Encourage the pupils to think about someone or something that they are thankful for, e.g. family, friends, pets, animals, hobbies, sports, musical instruments or any other relevant ideas that come to mind. When they have thought of something, encourage them to make a model of it.
